During this two hour-workshop, Grace Garvey will take us from the very basics of how to define professional ethics through a working knowledge and understanding of ethical concepts and their applications in your business. The workshop discussion will include ways in which practicing under a code of ethics can help professionals work more effectively (and avoid potential pitfalls) with clients, fellow contractors, town officials and regulators. More than just a nice idea, ethics should be a guiding force in your daily business as well as personal exchanges. A review of rules of behavior, legal definitions, general codes, and specific codes of ethics (GSDI and NHANRS for certified soil and wetland scientists) and other similar professional codes will be included. Small group exercises will be a part of this workshop: this will involve discussing specific scenarios which is sure to enliven the conversation.

(This program will provide ethics education for certified or licensed professionals looking to take a two-hour ethics training program.)
